- Registrations received after August 26 2019 will incur a \$100 plus GST late fee

#### **PAYMENT OPTIONS**

When registering, delegates can

- 1. Pay by visa or master card at that time (charges apply)
  - a. Tax receipts will be issued
- 2. Opt not to pay by credit card and receive a Tax Invoice by email after which
  - a. Pay by EFT via details published on the Tax Invoice
  - b. Pay by visa or master card over the phone (charges apply)
- 3. Part payments are acceptable as above (EG personal payment for accommodation + organisational payment for registration)

# **CANCELLATIONS**

Cancellations will be assessed on a case by case basis. Full refunds will only be granted if replacement registrations are received. Refunds will exclude accommodation, food and beverage deposits / costs.

#### **CONCURRENT SESSION SELECTIONS**

When the full program is available delegates will receive notification and be able to pre-register for their preferences. This is expected to be in April 2019. Delegates will be able to log into their initial registration and update it accordingly.
